To kick off a week of celebration, the NAIDOC march will be held at 10am on the 5th of July. Meeting at Clyde Campbell carpark, opposite Koori Mail, the march will go through the Lismore CBD and conclude at the Quad. It is a community event for all ages to honour the history of NAIDOC together.
