Dear Parents and Carers,

Our school Dental and Optical visits were scheduled from the 31<sup>st</sup> of October to the 4<sup>th</sup> of November. The Dental visit has commenced and will continue until the 4<sup>th</sup> of November, if required. The Optical visit has been postponed and will occur from the 1<sup>st</sup> of Dec to the 9<sup>th</sup> of December, depending on the number of students.

If you have submitted your forms, your child/ren will be eligible for both visits. If you have not given permission for your child to attend, please complete the paper forms you were provided with last term, enquire at the office for additional forms and submit as soon as possible, or alternatively, book online using these links.

The Optical visit offers FULLY BULKBILLED eye checks with highly qualified optometrists and offer free spectacles through 'Vision Australia' for students whose family's receive benefits.

Once your child has been assessed by the Mobile Eyes optometrist a report will be sent home. Children who are eligible for free glasses as per the criteria below can apply through Vision Australia. We have provided a list of optometrists below who provide these free glasses, and the prescription can be filled there. Alternatively, parents and carers may submit their Centrelink statement to Mobileyes and the student can choose something on the day directly, through Mobileyes.

# To be eligible for the NSW Spectacles Program, Centrelink Recipients must:

- Be an Australian permanent resident and resident of NSW
- Receive the maximum rate of a full benefit or pension (e.g. aged pension, disability support pension, newstart allowance etc.)
- Receive no additional income aside from their Centrelink payment.
- Have cash/savings or assets less than \$500 (if single) or \$1000 (if married/partnered, or with dependents)
