# **BroSpeak Professional Learning**

Three of our staff members completed BroSpeak training today – Mr Coulter, Trevor Bolt and Clinton Kenn. The program is designed for Aboriginal students in years 4 to 11, with the aim of encouraging students to focus on education and career pathways, increase student self-esteem, strengthen their sense of identity, belonging and cultural connection to the community in which they live. We are fortunate to now have 5 staff members trained in this wonderful program.



# **Important Information regarding Illness**

There has been a significant number of students attending school with symptoms of illness, including runny noses, cough and sore throat.

As per the NSW Department of Education advice, we ask that you keep your child at home if they have any symptoms of colds/flu/Covid.

A common illness going through the community at the moment is "RSV", respiratory syncytial virus. RSV is highly infectious, and the best way to help stop the virus spreading is for everyone to always practice good hygiene, especially if you have flu-like symptoms and stay at home if you have these symptoms.

All students, staff and their families should follow NSW Health's advice to reduce the risk of not only COVID-19, but also other illnesses that may affect our schools this winter such as the flu. We can all protect our loved ones and our community by:

- staying home if unwell or if displaying any COVID-19 symptoms
- keeping up to date with our vaccinations including the flu vaccine, which is available from your local GP, pharmacy or Aboriginal Medical Service now
- flu vaccines are free for all children aged 6 months to under 5 years, or for a small charge for those aged 5 years and older
- getting tested immediately for COVID-19 if you become symptomatic and isolating until you receive a negative result
- practicing good hand hygiene by washing regularly with soap and water.
- taking a RAT before visiting vulnerable loved ones or going to large gatherings and events.

We understand that this can be difficult, however, we are having more and more staff catch these illnesses, which means they cannot come to school to teach your children.

In a number of cases, this has resulted in staff developing pneumonia, a very serious illness, which takes a long time to recover from.

I ask you to PLEASE keep your child/ren at home if they have any symptoms of illness, however 'small' you might think the symptoms are.

Thank you for keeping us all safe.
