Department of Education – Check-in Assessment

On Tuesday the 13th and Wednesday 14th of September, Year 6 students will participate in the Check-in assessment. The Check-in assessment is a NSW Department of Education online literacy and numeracy assessment available to support schools to assess and monitor student learning.

The assessment supplements existing school practices to identify how students are performing in literacy and numeracy and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs. Students with a disability may receive the same level of support during the assessment they would normally receive in the classroom.

All year 6 students will complete a reading assessment, a numeracy assessment, and a writing task.

Fox Street Preschool Visits

This term, 3/4C has been making fortnightly visits to Fox Street Pre-school where our students have been building relationships through literacy. Our students have been demonstrating what it means and looks like to be at big school, and they have been amazing role models for the younger children.

Our visits are beginning to have an impact on the children at Fox Street Pre-school. The educators performed a bit of a survey to discuss what it is their children like most about the visits from 3/4C. Below are some of the comments.

Harvey – "I like that they speak nicely when they read books"

Jordy – "I enjoy reading with lots of people"

Poet – "I like to see when they come in"

Baxter – "I like it when they read to you"

Tahlo – "I can't wait. Everything about the nice friends reading books"

Our students are certainly demonstrating how they can influence the world around them, simply through the joy of sharing a good story.

We look forward to continuing the program into term 4.
