Dear Parents/Carers,

Education Hardship Funds Re:

In 2022 the NSW Minister for Education announced a funding package to support Public Schools (and other education and care service providers) in 7 identified Local Government Areas (LGAs) affected by the floods in the Northern Rivers, including Ballina.

The Education Hardship Fund provided \$500.00 for each of our students enrolled at the time of the floods.

We wish to advise that any remaining Education Hardship Funds are to be used by Friday 8th December, 2023. Any unused funds will be returned to the Department after this date.

What can the funds be used for?

Parents and carers can request to use the funds for school-related activities and expenses including:

- Excursions, camps and incursions.
- School-organised formals.
- Ballina Public School Uniforms, Shoes & Stationery (The School Locker).
- Students going into Year 7 next year, can purchase high school uniforms (The School Locker).
- School Shoes (Intersport).
- Book Fair Ballina Public School.
- School sports including PSSA carnivals.

To purchase from The School Locker or Intersport, please attend the store and select your items. You will be provided with an invoice to bring to our administration office for processing. The store will contact you when the items are ready for collection.

Unfortunately, the funds cannot be used for voluntary school contributions, nor redeemed for cash.

Please ensure you take advantage of these funds before *Friday 8th December*, 2023.
