Dental & Optical Visit

Dear Parents and Carers,

NSW Eye and Dental Care is offering free screenings to students at Ballina Public School from Monday the 16th of October to Friday the 20th of October 2023. This Dental service is provided under the Child Dental Benefits Scheme of the Australian Government.

The screenings are free of charge for eligible students, the services include:

- Dental examination
- Dental X-rays
- Preventive Oral Care, such as oral hygiene assistance, cleaning of teeth and the application of fluoride to the teeth.

The Eye Care service includes a report regarding your child's eye health and a prescription will be provided if glasses are required along with options for very affordable frame and lens packages. To secure your child's appointment please register your consent online at:
